WELL-BEING

- The unemployment rate in Atkinson is 3 % while the Georgia average is 3.9%.
- 34% of children in Atkinson are living in poverty, while the Georgia average is 20%.
- 46% of children in Atkinson live in single parent families while the Georgia average is 34%

MENTAL HEALTH

- 10% of youth in Atkinson expressed that they've seriously considered attempting suicide while the Georgia average is 6%.
- 84% of youth in Atkinson expressed that they've felt stressed.

SEXUAL & REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

- The teen pregnancy rate in Georgia is 9.9 per.
- The Georgia average teen birth rate is 16.5 per 1,000.
- 14% of teen mothers in Georgia are giving birth to a second chilld.
- The STD incidence of youth in Atkinson is 29.1 per 1,000, compared to the Georgia average of 28.3 per 1,000.

PHYSICAL HEALTH & NUTRITION

- 9% of youth in Atkinson consumed alcohol in the last 30 days while the Georgia average is 8%.
- The obesity rate in Atkinson is 41% while the Georgia average is 34%.
- 28% of the youth in Atkinson were not physically active for at least 60 minutes in the last 7 days.
