WELL-BEING

- The unemployment rate in Bryan is 3 % while the Georgia average is 3.9%.
- 10% of children in Bryan are living in poverty, while the Georgia average is 20%.
- 26% of children in Bryan live in single parent families while the Georgia average is 34%

SEXUAL & REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

- The teen pregnancy rate in Bryan is 10.8per 1,000, compared to the Georgia average of 9.9 per 1,000.
- The teen birth rate in Bryan is 10.4per 1,000, compared to the Georgia average of 16.5 per 1,000.
- 14% of teen mothers in Georgia are giving birth to a second child.
- The STD incidence of youth in Bryan is 17.6 per 1,000, compared to the Georgia average of 28.3 per 1,000.

MENTAL HEALTH

• 11% of youth in Bryan expressed that they've seriously considered attempting suicide while the Georgia average is 6%.

PHYSICAL HEALTH & NUTRITION

- 13% of youth in Bryan consumed alcohol in the last 30 days while the Georgia average is 8%.
- The obesity rate in Bryan is 41% while the Georgia average is 40%.
